Policy for Use of the Parish House for Special Occasions

The rooms in the Parish House that are available for use for special occasions are restricted to the Fellowship Hall, restrooms, kitchen, and small classrooms.

When considering renting space in the Parish House, please be aware of the following:

- Trinity Episcopal Church requires a completed “Agreement for One-Time Use of Church Facilities” or “Agreement for Multiple-Use of Church Facilities.”
- Trinity requires you to familiarize yourself with and agree to follow all “Rules for Parish House Use.”
- When renting the largest room (Fellowship Hall), your use is restricted to that room and the restrooms unless you also arrange to rent the kitchen and/or small room(s) for an additional fee(s).
- The parish office and the equipment therein are never available for use as part of a rental agreement.
- Trinity has available tables and chairs for a maximum of 100 people.
- Trinity does not offer catering.
- Trinity does not provide people to serve food.
- Trinity does not provide linens.
- You are responsible for all setup and clean-up.
- Trash must be placed in sealed garbage bags and disposed of in the trash cans located outside the kitchen door.
