Notes from Bishop Matthew Heyd

The most important thing we do is to care for each other because it's a sign of God's unconditional love for us.

Three weeks ago, we announced three Easter Invitations to care for clergy and communities across our Diocese.

- We want to weave a strong pastoral fabric that supports our clergy and congregations in every part of our Diocese.
- A strong pastoral fabric means that our diocesan culture and common life lets us know that we are seen, heard, and loved.

The fabric becomes real in how our structures support our everyday life. *The Clergy Critical Needs Fund* has long supported medical and educational needs for clergy across the Diocese. It was originally endowed by Trinity Church Wall Street and now draws from three different endowed funds at the discretion of the bishop diocesan. The annual amount is \$180,000.

I have directed the Clergy Critical Needs committee to deploy \$100,000 from accumulated funds to provide immediate support for our deacons and priests.

The \$100,000 in Easter Invitation support will be a special initiative in addition to the annual amount. It's drawn from funds unspent over the past several years.

- I'm grateful to Bishop **Andrew St. John** for chairing the Clergy Critical Needs committee over the last decade, supported by Canon **Jeanne Person** as well as **Bishop Glasspool** and Bishop **Andy Dietsche**. The whole Committee has done really careful work to respond to important needs.
- I have asked the Rev. **Michelle Meech** and the Rev. **Ben Nnaji** to serve as the new co-chairs. This spring they will work with the full Committee on both how to best use the \$100,000 and how we can adjust guidelines to best use the \$180,000 for clergy support each year.
- They will announce the guidelines for the special initiative. The annual funding will continue to be available with the current guidelines, as the Committee considers revisions.

These funds provide an important element in our wider pastoral fabric that also includes the ministry of clericus deans across the Diocese and support for continuing education and vocational support. All the ministry of the diocesan staff, in every area, is pastoral in the deepest sense.

It's our intent to always search for more threads to strengthen the fabric.

The Holy Spirit moves at ground level—because the Spirit first moves within each of us. It's how we're created. The Spirit also draws us together. We're made for belonging and connection.

We cannot shelter from the changes for our churches.

We can care for each other and create the tools we need to navigate through.
