Notes from Bishop Matthew Heyd

We are stronger together.

We are committed to engaging widely as we change. All our ministries depend on the gifts and offerings of our people.

Jesus said, we are salt+light together— created in God's image as people of infinite worth and infinite promise.

I began work as coadjutor-elect last May 1. In the time since, we've focused on widely engaging our people from every part of the Diocese. We've looked for diversity in every dimension—background, region, order of ministry, and length of tenure in the Diocese. We're using a reparations lens for all of our work.

Renewal comes, in part, from joining new voices with experienced leaders.

· There are canonical offices elected by convention—including Standing Committee, elected members of Diocesan Council and Trustees, and deputies to General Convention. The Leadership Development Commission will begin the nominating process for these offices early this summer.

- The bishop diocesan appoints committees and chairs not otherwise specified in the canons. This role of "talent-spotting" is important to me and I'm excited to work collaboratively with bishops, canons, and leaders across the Diocese to identify new leaders.
- · In the last year we've made 106 appointments to roles including Diocesan Council, Commission on Ministry, Ordination Task Force, Mission Review Leadership, and search committees for chief of finance and operations and property support director.
- · We've also named new chairs or co-chairs for the Commission on Ministry, the Budget Committee, Clergy Critical Needs, Adjustment Board, the Deacons' Committee, and the Congregational Life & Mission Commission.
- · Nearly half of the appointments (47%) are new to diocesan leadership; 40% are people of color. We've appointed more clergy than lay leaders in this first year; as our staff and I are out in the Diocese and meet more leaders, this balance will change.

We've shared these new appointments through the year. We'll continue to announce appointments in this Monday email.
