***Monday Morning Notes from Bishop Hyed***

**On Memorial Day we remembered with gratitude those who have lost their lives serving our country.**

We are also thankful for those who continue to serve today. The Diocese of New York is home to the US Military Academy at West Point as well as to programs serving veterans.

Today we highlight the *Veteran & Community Rally Point* at St. Andrew's in Walden, part of the Wallkill River Episcopal Ministry with St. Francis Montgomery.

- The two-year old program meets monthly for dinner for peer support and to discuss veterans benefits. The community gathered last Saturday evening.

The Rev. **Nicole Hanley**, rector of St. Andrew's & St. Francis, has described why these gatherings are crucial— so many veterans have difficulty returning to civilian life. “Our veterans are quietly suffering. We want to show up for each other, and especially for our veterans, so that they keep being here with us, and they never have to feel that shame in being alone.”

**Nathan Parker**— a US Marine Corps Veteran and member of St. Andrew’s— said on Saturday night, “The military doesn't teach you how to come home. This is how you come home.”
